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NEW INDUSTRIAL POLICY

Chhattisgarh offers incentives for hiring Agniveers, former Maoists

ENCOURAGING COMPANIES to hire persons with disabilities (PWDs), Agniveers and surrendered Maoists by offering a 40% salary reimbursement and giving such people an additional 10% benefit on Fixed Capital Investment (FCI) are among the major highlights of Chhattisgarh's new industrial policy.

Rollout on Thursday by the state's Vishnu Deo Singh government, the 2024-30 policy aims at job creation, offering measures such as reimbursing Employees Provident Fund (EPF) apart from salaries and customising incentives and provisions to cater to the needs of specific industries.

Three distinct measures have been taken to encourage industry to skill labour themselves. This includes reimbursing up to ₹15,000 of a person's first salary and 75% of their provident fund up to five years.

"Once they provide on-the-job training to an employee for 12 months, we will pay ₹15,000 as the person's first month salary. This will not only help them lower their cost of operations but help them in getting a skilled employee who meets their productive outcome," the policy reads.

The policy also offers "be-

speaking" incentives for units investing over ₹100 crore or "generating over 1,000 jobs". Explaining this, an official said: "For the first time in Chhattisgarh with an aim to create jobs we are offering a tailor-made bespoke policy based on the amount of investment. This means apart from providing them all the existing government benefits, we shall work with them on any point that comes up while setting up an industry. This will mainly encourage the recreation sector, textiles, pharmaceuticals, IT data centres among other large job creating sectors".

The policy also lays special emphasis on encouraging companies to hire PWDs, Agniveers and surrendered Maoists by offering a net salary reimbursement of up to ₹5 lakh per annum for one person.

Additionally, PWDs, Agniveers, surrendered Maoists, people from SC, ST or women starting an enterprise of their own will get an additional 10% benefit on FCI taking the total benefits to their company to 33%.

Meanwhile, in order to make land available immediately for setting up industries, the government has identified 75 land banks spread across nearly 1,000 acres. The state is also planning to turn at least four of these banks into smart industrial parks in the next few months.

PMLA case: ED searches premises linked to 'Lottery King' Martin

THE ENFORCEMENT Directorate (ED) Thursday conducted raids on premises linked to Coimbatore-based businessman Santiago Martin aka "lottery king", targeting locations in Tamil Nadu, Kolkata, and Siliguri. The raids involved Martin's office and residence in Coimbatore, as well as multiple locations across Chennai and other cities.

According to ED sources, a search of 30 places were targeted and the process under way till evening. This action follows a recent court ruling that reopened an investigation into alleged money laundering activities associated with Martin.

The raids come as part of an ongoing investigation after revelations that Martin's lottery business donated more than ₹1,300 crore in electoral bonds to various political parties between 2019 and 2024.

The ED's action aligns with a decision by the Madras HC two weeks prior, which overturned a lower court's dismissal of charges and mandated further investigation. The case dates back to March 2012, when the Chennai Crime Branch seized ₹72 crore from the residence of Nagarajan, an associate of Martin's. The cash, according to Nagarajan, was generated from lottery sales involving Martin and his wife, Leema Rose, across Kerala and Maharashtra. This led the Chennai Crime Branch to file a FIR for money laundering against Nagarajan, Martin, and Leema Rose, triggering an ED inquiry under the Prevention of

Money Laundering Act (PMLA) of 2002. However, in 2022, the Crime Branch filed a closure report, claiming insufficient evidence to substantiate money laundering. The Alandur Judicial Magistrate accepted this report, effectively closing the case. The ED challenged this decision in the Madras HC, which ultimately quashed the closure order and questioned the integrity of the Crime Branch's investigation. On October 28 expressing suspicion over the sudden shift in the Crime Branch's stance. The Madras HC's judgment provided a scathing critique of the lower court's acceptance of the closure. Justice Smt Subramanian and Justice V Sivanaganan noted that the closure was filed despite overwhelming evidence, including a bank statement intended to launder illegal funds.

Ashok Chavan opposes 'batenge toh katenge', joins Ajit Pawar chorus

A DAY after BJP leader and MLC Pankaj Munde distanced herself from the "batenge to katenge" statement, another party leader, Rajya Sabha MP and former Maharashtra chief minister Ashok Chavan said the slogan was not in good taste and irrelevant and that the people will not appreciate it.

In an interview to Press Trust of India (PTI) on Wednesday,

Chavan said he doesn't attach much importance to the "vote jhad" - "dharna-yuddha" rhetoric, as the BJP and ruling Mahayuti policy is development of the country and Maharashtra. UP CM and senior BJP leader Yogi Adityanath had been raising the slogan of "batenge to katenge" in his election campaign rallies ahead of the November 20 Maharashtra assembly polls. Chavan told PTI, "There is no relevance of this slogan. Slogans are given at election time. This particular slogan is not in good taste

and I don't think people will appreciate it. Personally speaking, I am not in favour of such slogans." "Every political functionary has to take a decision after a lot of thinking. We also have to see that nobody's sentiments are hurt," Chavan added. He was speaking at Ardurip in Nanded during his election campaign for the Mahayuti, Maharashtra Deputy Chief Minister and BJP leader Devendra Fadnis last week had said "vote jihad" would be countered by "dharna-yuddha" of votes.

MONEY LAUNDERING CASES OF Rs 125 CR searches 24 locations in Maharashtra, Gujarat

Trader with multiple bank accounts in Malegaon under lens

THE ENFORCEMENT Directorate (ED) on Thursday carried out searches at 24 locations in Maharashtra and neighbouring Gujarat as part of a money-laundering probe into a Malegaon trader who allegedly misused bank accounts for electoral malpractice.

The central agency carried out the searches at premises linked to the trader and shell companies in Thane, Vashi, Malegaon and Nashik in Maharashtra, and Surat and Ahmedabad in Gujarat under provisions of the Prevention of Money Laundering Act (PMLA). The case involves money laundering of Rs 125 crore.

Agency sources said that the case is related to the opening of multiple bank accounts in Malegaon by one Siraj Ahmed Harun Memon, a trader who owns a tea and cold drink agency.

The ED's action is based on a First Information Report (FIR) registered by the Malegaon police on November 7 against Memon on the complaint of a local youth, Jayesh Misal, and 11 others. Memon was booked and later arrested.

With Maharashtra set to vote on November 20, it was alleged that Memon was utilis-

ing funds meant for election but the staff there allegedly did not help them. They then took the police that their accounts were allegedly misused by Siraj for illegal money transactions, states the FIR.

Over a dozen bank accounts were opened in the past two months. When the ED obtained the transaction details of these accounts, it was found to be around 125 crore.

The anti-money laundering agency suspects Memon may be using the bank accounts and banking system for routing money for some individuals. The agency is also looking into allegations that the money will be used for electoral purposes. So far, no political leader's name has cropped up directly in the investigation.

On Thursday morning, BJP leader Kirt Somaiya termed the matter as a "Vote Jihad Funding" scam, alleging that the money from these bank accounts was withdrawn from election during the election. Somaiya also claimed that he met the Malegaon police regarding the alleged scam.
